## 2020 BOARD OF EDUCATION ELECTION INFORMATION

The election for members of the Hoboken Board of Education will be held on **Tuesday, November 3, 2020**. There are three (3) seats for a three- (3-) year term which will be voted upon. The terms of Sharyn Angley, Chetali Khanna and Melanie Tekirian are expiring.

The deadline for filing to seek a seat on the nine-member board is **July 27, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.**

Petitions are available on the county clerk's website at [www.hudsoncountyclerk.org](http://www.hudsoncountyclerk.org), if candidates wish to receive a hard copy of the petition, they must call the County Clerk Office for an appointment.

Completed nominating petitions must be submitted in person or electronically by either facsimile or email and must be received by 4:00 pm on July 27, 2020. Individuals submitting petitions in person must make an appointment by calling the Elections Division at 201-369-3470 Option #6. Anyone in need of a hard copy of the petition, an appointment is required for pick up.

The County Clerk – Elections Division is open between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. and is located at 257 Cornelison Ave., 4th Floor, Jersey City, NJ 07302. The contact number is 201-369-3470 extension 2767 or option 6.

Pursuant to Bill S868, signed by Governor Murphy, board of education candidates are allowed to circulate a nominating petition jointly and to be bracketed together on the ballot (sample individual and group nominating petitions are available online in the NJSBA Candidate Kit).

Candidates filing a nominating petition for board membership must meet the following qualifications:

- He/She is a citizen of the United States of America
- He/She must be at least 18 (eighteen) years of age to qualify for office
- He/She must be able to read and write
- He/She has been a resident of the municipality from which he/she is to be elected for at least one year preceding the date of the election
- He/She is not disqualified as a voter pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:4-1
- He/She is a registered voter in the district
- He/She has not been convicted of a disqualifying crime pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:12-1
- He/she has no interest in any contract with, or claim against, the Board.
