Culinary Celebrates Mexican Tradition

For Día de los Muertos (Day of the Dead), Culinary I classes joined forces with Mrs. Cruz's Spanish classes. We created Sugar skulls, a traditional folk art from Southern Mexico used to celebrate the Day of the Dead. Traditionally in Mexico, sugar skulls, marigolds, incense and special foods decorate an ofrenda (altar). Our ofrenda included photos of loved ones, incense and sugar skulls. We learned how to make empanada dough from scratch and made fillings from roasted pork, pulled chicken and house ground beef.

Divina Arias was kind enough to bring in some dried hibiscus flowers so that we were able to make the traditional "Agua de Jamaica"

During Friday's PGP we had a feast with the empanadas that were made during class time, and cookies. Then we washed it all down with a cup of agua de Jamaica. It was a wonderful time to remember the individuals who are no longer with us, surrounded by classmates in a fun and festive environment

Remember that school is closed on November 10th and November 11th for NJEA Teachers Convention, and we will be back on November 14th. Enjoy the long weekend!






Wallace School's Buddy Bench
